By registering for the 54th Annual ESDR Meeting (as of sending the filled in online registration form), you confirm that you have read, accepted, and agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions, including liabilities and the applicable law. If you do not agree to these Terms and Conditions, do not register for the 54th Annual ESDR Meeting. By completing the registration on behalf of another individual, you are warranting that you have informed the participant that these Terms and Conditions apply to the registration and participation of the 54th Annual ESDR Meeting, and you have shared a copy of these Terms and Conditions.

ESDR reserves the right to unilaterally change these Terms and Conditions, at its sole discretion at any time and without prior notice, whenever it deems necessary.

Registration for the ESDR Annual Meeting

Registration for the 54th Annual ESDR Meeting can be made via the website of ESDR: <https://esdrmeeting.org/registration>. All registrations must be processed online via an online registration form. For this, please click on the “Registration” button and follow the instructions step by step. Specific information may be requested during the registration process for individuals and group registrations directly or indirectly related to the code of conducts applicable to the organization of an ESDR Meeting and pharmaceutical industry’s compliance regulations. Upon completion of your online registration, you will be sent an acknowledgement email. The email is sent to the email address provided on the registration form and will include an invoice.

Registration fees

Registration fees for the 54th Annual ESDR Meeting may vary depending on the date you register, as indicated by the registration categories and deadlines on the registration website. All registration fees referred to are in Euro (€), no other currency will be accepted. 21% Belgian VAT is charged on Registration fees.

Payment & confirmation

All registration fees referred to are in Euro (€). All registration payments must be made in Euro. No other currency will be accepted. No cash or checks are accepted. Full payment is due for the registration fees. Registrations are only confirmed once the required payment has been received. You will receive a confirmation email from the 54th Annual ESDR Meeting Organizer (ESDR@wearemci.com) upon receipt of the payment.

Only digital versions of invoices will be sent to participants upon completion of the registration. The invoice will be issued using the contact details, or additional address details, provided on the registration form.

Payment by credit card - VISA, Eurocard/MasterCard, American Express

The online registration platform is a secured site. VISA, Eurocard/MasterCard and American Express are the only credit cards accepted via the registration system. Payment by credit card is recommended as then your registration is immediately confirmed.

Name changes

For name changes an administrative fee of €45 will be charged. For each name change you must notify the meeting organizer **by e-mail to ESDR@wearemci.com**. Name change participants agree to take over all booked program items of the originally registered participant.

Cancellation policy

In case you wish to fully cancel your Meeting registration, the meeting organizer must be notified **in writing by sending an e-mail to ESDR@wearemci.com**

The following cancellation conditions apply:

- In case the cancellation is received **before or on 9 July 2025**, 23:59 CEST the registration fee will be refunded with a deduction of EUR 100, as administration charge.
- In case the cancellation is received **after 9 July 2025**, 23:59 CEST, the registration fee will not be refunded for cancellations or no-shows.

Any refunds due will be processed within 30 days after the meeting dates.

Invitation letter for visa application

All delegates requiring a letter of invitation for visa application purposes may request this letter during the online registration. We will not be able to issue any letter of invitation without receiving the registration and the payment of the required registration fees. Please note that the organizers will not be able to contact or intervene with any Embassy or Consulate office on behalf of a delegate. ESDR cannot be held responsible if your Visa is not approved and registration fees cannot be remitted.
